

Start loading your ammo! The Premier Event of the 50 BMG match year 2010, Our FCSA World Championships will be held at the NRA Whittington Center in Raton, NM this year July 1-4th. This will be a 4 day contiguous event. (See Agenda) This event hosts the annual membership meeting and provides a venue for the exchange of ideas, information and develop camaraderie as well as the opportunity for the 50 BMG shooters to compete and develop bragging rights for the next year.

The theme this year is Ironman... all of the Ironman shooters will compete together and will start and finish the 4 day continuous match. All Ironmen will be shooting in the same relays at the same times. This means we can have up to 40 Ironman Shooters considering there are roughly 40 positions comfortably available on the line.

Should a person want to register for a 2 day event, shooting only 2 classes (**Ironman is not available in the 2 day format**) perhaps Hunter and Heavy on either the Thursday/Friday or Saturday/Sunday they will register and shoot and be scored for those days. Should they register for Thursday/Friday their plaque(s) will be sent to them and they may designate a friend to choose any prize they may win. This will provide a format that includes all of those interested in the 2 day format. I expect that shooters who want to register for 2 day events may only do so either for Thur/Fri or Sat Sun ... there will be NO registrations allowed for say "Fri/Sat".

The 2 gun award rule changes will score AS WRITTEN!

We recommend you get your room reservations as soon as possible.

Any person who attends and shoots their first WC will be considered a Rookie. Here's the criteria:

Gayle McMillan Rookie Of The Year Award Qualifications

FCSA World Championships, Raton, NM 2010

To be eligible for the Gayle McMillan Rookie of the Year Award the Shooter must be a first time World Championship participant. No other factors will be considered.

Shooters must claim eligibility for this award when they sign in at the range. All of the class scores an eligible competitor competes in will be considered for each competitor and the best class aggregate/score factor will be used.

Junior Shooters must declare eligibility for this award at registration. If they do not declare eligibility as a junior shooter, they may shoot in the world championships without declaring until they are 18 at which time they must declare eligibility.

The winner will be decided by the highest aggregate group/score factor amongst all eligible participants.

If you are not able to get registered online please contact the FCSA Office and request a registration packet.
