FCSA 2011 World Championships

Start loading your ammo! The Premier Event of the 50 BMG match year 2011, our FCSA World Championships, will be held at the NRA Whittington Center in Raton, NM this year June 30 – July 3rd. This will be a 5 day contiguous event including one day for registration/sight in and four days of shooting. (See Agenda) Competitors are required to shoot whichever class(s) of competition they register for on the days designated for those classes of competition. Unlimited/Hunter will be fired on Thursday/Friday and Light/Heavy will be fired on Saturday/Sunday.

This event hosts the annual membership meeting and provides a venue for the exchange of ideas, information and development of camaraderie as well as the opportunity for 50 BMG shooters to compete and claim bragging rights for the next year.

Gayle McMillan Rookie Of The Year Award Qualifications

FCSA World Championships, Raton, NM 2011

The Rookie of the Year (ROTY) award shall be presented to that competitor who fired the best combination of group & score in any recognized class of competition while competing as a first time competitor at the FCSA World Championship Match.

Participation in regional match FCSA competition is not disqualifying to compete as ROTY as long as the competitor's regional match experience occurred after the end of the FCSA World Championship match of the previous year. Junior Class shooters are exempt from this policy.

(If a Junior Shooter does desire to compete for ROTY, they must claim eligibility for this award when they sign in at the range. If a Junior Shooter does compete for ROTY, they are no longer eligible to compete for ROTY after becoming 18 years old. If they do not compete for ROTY as a Junior Shooter, they become eligible to compete for ROTY the 1st year after adulthood.)

The winner will be decided by the lowest aggregate group/score factor amongst all eligible participants.

Match fees will be \$75 per class for Light, Heavy, Hunter, Unlimited, and Junior. Practical Match fees will be \$75, Semi-Auto \$75, and Team fees \$20 per team member.

Registration is available online. We recommend you get your housing soon. If you are not able to get registered online please contact the FCSA Office and request a registration packet.
